#### Entry Policy

For exhibits in Horticultural Hall and Old Main, use Gate 2 (Madison Ave. at Richland Ave.) only!

**There is no entry fee.** Exhibitors, upon delivery of their article or articles to the proper department, will be given an exhibitors ticket which will bear the identifying numbers of the exhibit. This entitles Exhibitors to purchase one (1) Exhibitor Admission Ticket (\$8.00 value) for \$4.00 for each item entered. These Special Tickets are available in the Exhibition Hall when entering your items. **THEY WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE ON ANY OTHER DATES. ONLY ONE TICKET PER ITEM ENTERED.**

Tickets will be Void if reproduced or tampered with in any way. Exhibits which have been erroneously entered may, at the discretion of the Director in Charge and Superintendent of the Department, be transferred to the proper class previous to the judging. If such classes have been judged they shall not be re-judged.

Premiums shall be paid only on awards indicated by Judges' records. Names shall be covered on exhibits until judging is completed.

In the absence of competition in any class, the right is reserved to award premiums which the exhibit merits.



## 4-H Family and Consumer Sciences

Personal entries must be made in Exhibition Building #1 (Old Main) on the Fairgrounds, Wednesday, September 4, 2019, 2:00-6:00pm. Exhibits must be picked up Monday, September 16, 2019, noon-7:00pm.

### Rules:

- Each article must be an item made by an enrolled 4-H member as part of 4-H projects taken within the current year.
- Posters must measure 14" X 22" to be judged. They will be judged on the basis of visual impact, creativity, neatness, and accuracy. Posters must have been exhibited at the York County 4-H Fair.
- Do not exhibit any substances that could be toxic or harmful to others (for example: blasting devices left in rockets, medicines in first aid kit, formaldehyde in containers, etc.).
- A 4-H member may enter only one item per subclass.

### Division 4-H Food

#### Rules:

- Exhibitor must be carrying 4-H foods projects as noted to be eligible to enter classes.
- Foods other than canned goods should be displayed on a paper plate and covered with plastic wrap.
